Leadership Roles and Contributions

- **President:** World Society of Arrhythmias
From ISCP to WSA
- **President:** AIAC and ANMCO
- **Contributions:** Advancements in pacing, defibrillation, CRT
- **Advocate** for remote monitoring of cardiac devices

'Progress in Clinical Pacing' Congress

- **Founded in 1984, held biennially in Rome**
- **Covered pacing, arrhythmias, syncope, heart failure**
- **Key event for international collaboration**



'Il Cuore di Roma' and Public Engagement

- **Public education on cardiovascular health**
- **Screened over 24,000 adolescents with ECG**
- **Co-authored 'Il Mio Cuore Elettrico' with Dr. Luca Santini**

- **Known as 'The Emperor of Rome' in cardiology**
- **Renowned for leadership, care, and mentorship**
